Trough Tray	Steel, Aluminum	Galvanized, Painted	Medium cable loads, protection from dust and debris
Solid Bottom Tray	Steel, Aluminum	Galvanized, Painted	Sensitive cables, minimal heat buildup, EMI protection
Channel Tray	Steel, Aluminum	Galvanized, Painted	Short runs, branch connections, aesthetic installations
Wire Mesh Tray	Steel, Stainless Steel	Galvanized, Powder-coated	Light cables, flexible routing, industrial and commercial

Parameter	Typical Values / Notes
Rung Spacing	6–9 inches (150–230 mm) for ladder trays; adjust for cable type and weight
Inside Depth	Varies by tray size; commonly 4–12 inches for ladder trays
Support Span	Depends on load class; typical spans 5–10 feet for medium loads
Load Class	Defines maximum uniform load per span; affects tray design and cost
Bend Radius	Minimum bend radius per cable type; ensures no damage to cables
Accessories	Bends, tees, elbows, drop-outs, splice plates, expansion joints, clamps, brackets, hanger rods
Installation Mounts	Floors, walls, ceilings, equipment racks, cabinets
