Step 1: Enable SNMP on Core Switches

To monitor core switches, ensure SNMP (Simple Network Management Protocol) is enabled on each device. SNMP allows monitoring tools to query switch status, port activity, CPU/memory usage, and traffic statistics. Configure SNMP with a community string (v1/v2c) or user credentials (v3) depending on your security requirements. Verify SNMP functionality using commands like `snmpwalk` to confirm that OIDs return descriptive values rather than numeric codes .

Step 2: Choose a Monitoring Platform

Select a monitoring tool that supports multi-vendor switches and provides real-time dashboards, alerts, and trend analysis. Popular options include:

- Zabbix: Supports SNMP monitoring, MIB file integration, and host templates for switches .
- Nagios Core: Uses plugins like `check_snmp` and `check_mrtgtraf` to monitor port status, bandwidth, and device availability .
- ManageEngine OpManager: Offers pre-built Core Switches device templates for quick discovery and performance monitoring .
