

Connect two optical modules to one optical fiber

To connect an optical module (SFP) to a fiber optic cable, ensure compatibility, remove dust caps, align connectors carefully, and secure the connection while following safety precautions.

Step 1: Verify Compatibility

Before connecting, confirm that the SFP module matches the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and the network equipment supports the module's transmission rate (1G, 10G, 25G, etc.).
