Summary of Content

Core switches act as the high-speed backbone of a network, while gateway devices connect internal networks to external networks or the internet.

Core Switches

A core switch is a high-capacity, high-performance Layer 3 switch positioned at the backbone of an enterprise network . It aggregates traffic from distribution switches and ensures ultra-low latency and maximum throughput across the network . Core switches are optimized for speed, scalability, and fault tolerance, forming the central nervous system of the network . They handle massive traffic volumes without performing resource-intensive tasks like deep packet inspection or complex access control, which are delegated to lower layers . Key characteristics include:

- High forwarding rate to manage large data volumes
 - Centralized connectivity between distribution layers
 - Minimal latency and maximum reliability
 - Typically deployed in large enterprises or data centers
- Core switches differ from access switches, which connect end-user devices like PCs, IP phones, and printers, and from distribution switches, which aggregate traffic from access switches and enforce policies such as VLAN routing and QoS .
