

Current parameters of the secondary distribution box



Overview

Most modern secondary networks are operated at AC rated voltage of 100-120 or 230-240 volts, at the frequency of 50 or 60 hertz. Operating voltage, required number of phases (three-phase or single-phase) and required reliability dictate topology and configuration of the network. This technical article explains six most common bus configurations used for distribution, transmission, or. The distribution box prevents that cascade — it receives power from the main supply, divides it into protected branch circuits, and isolates faults before they spread. The ACS takes the basic idea of zone wiring and combines it with pre-cut, pre-tested cable and plug-in connectors, to provide power and telecommunication systems that can be installed under raised floors (The Intelligent Floor), or in accessible ceilings (The Intelligent Ceiling).
