 - Inspect Wires: Before connecting, inspect both incoming and outgoing wires to ensure they are securely connected at the PDU panel. Pay special attention to the grounding (PE) cables to prevent electrical issues .
 - Connect Power: Connect the input power cord to a grounded electrical outlet that is easily accessible. Ensure all circuit breakers are in the off position before making connections .
