- **U-Bolt and Nut Assemblies:** Provide secure mechanical attachment and bonding to the tray, meeting NEC bonding requirements (). Adapters should be selected based on conduit size, tray type, and load requirements, ensuring that the connection does not damage cables or compromise grounding.
