A fiber optic cable consists of a core, cladding, buffer/coating, strengthening fibers, and an outer jacket, each serving a critical role in transmitting light signals efficiently and protecting the cable.

Core

The core is the central part of the fiber where light signals travel. It is typically made of ultra-pure silica glass (SiO_2), though some short-range applications use plastic cores. The core's diameter varies depending on the fiber type: single-mode fibers usually have a core of 8–10 microns, while multimode fibers range from 50 to 62.5 microns. The core's high purity and precise construction minimize signal loss and allow light to propagate over long distances with minimal attenuation .

Cladding

Surrounding the core is the cladding, which has a lower refractive index than the core. This difference enables total internal reflection, keeping the light confined within the core and preventing signal leakage. The cladding is usually coated with a thin layer of polymer, such as acrylate, to protect it from minor damage without affecting optical properties .
