Common Connector Types and Sizes

- **LC (Lucent Connector):** Features a 1.25mm ferrule, making it half the size of SC connectors. Its compact design allows high-density port arrangements and is ideal for modern data centers and high-speed networks .
- **SC (Subscriber Connector):** Uses a 2.5mm ferrule and a push-pull locking mechanism. SC connectors are widely used in general-purpose networking and are compatible with both single-mode and multimode fibers .
- **FC (Ferrule Connector):** Also has a 2.5mm ferrule but features a threaded design for secure connections, suitable for high-vibration or precision environments .
- **ST (Straight Tip):** Employs a 2.5mm ferrule with a bayonet-style twist-lock, commonly used in legacy multimode networks .
- **MTP/MPO (Multi-Fiber Push On/Pull Off):** Designed for multi-fiber applications, supporting 2, 4, 8, 12, 24, or up to 72 fibers per connector. These connectors are ideal for high-density racks and backbone cabling .
