

Distance between distribution box and switch box



Summary of Content

The distance between a distribution box and a switch box should not exceed 30 meters horizontally, with a vertical height from the ground typically between 1.3 and 1.6 meters.

Horizontal Distance

The horizontal distance between a distribution box and its associated switch box should not exceed 30 meters. This ensures efficient power distribution and minimizes voltage drop or safety risks. Additionally, the horizontal distance between the switch box and the fixed electrical equipment it controls should not exceed 3 meters to maintain proper control and safety compliance .

Vertical Height from Ground

For fixed installations, the bottom of the distribution box or switch box should be installed at a height between 1.3 meters and 1.5 meters from the ground. For mobile or temporary boxes, the height can range from 0.6 meters to 1.5 meters . The center point of the box is often recommended to be around 1.4–1.6 meters for ergonomic access during operation and maintenance .

Installation Considerations

- Distribution and switch boxes should be installed in dry, ventilated areas away from harmful gases, liquids, or heat sources .
- Separate power and lighting distribution boxes are recommended, or if combined, their circuits should be separated internally .
