Cable Management Tray Size: Choose a tray size that will hold the desired amount and length of cable. Support Spacing: Remember the NEC requires no more than 4 feet of support spacing. Bend Radius: The tray cable bend radius should be supported to avoid damaging. Understanding cable tray spacing is key to meeting safety regulations and maintaining system performance. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Proper installation can significantly reduce. Although BS 7671 touches on the subject of cable supports, it does not detail specifically what these support distances should be.
