- AB cables (Aerial Bundled Cables) for overhead low-voltage distribution, designed for safety and reduced line losses .
- Flexible control cables like Belden 70260PU, which are flame retardant, halogen-free, and suitable for moving parts or cable carriers in industrial applications .
- Standard single-core or multi-core copper cables for residential or commercial DB boxes, rated for 230/400 V AC systems .

Specification Indication

Cable specifications are indicated in several ways:

- Voltage and current rating: Printed on the cable sheath or provided in datasheets, e.g., 1.1 kV XLPE for low-voltage distribution .
