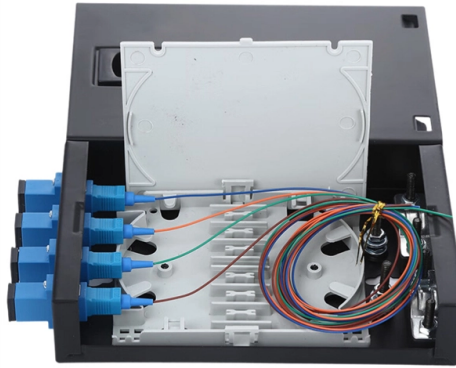

- **Residual Current Devices (RCD/RCCB):** Detect imbalances in current between live and neutral wires, cutting off power to prevent electric shocks.
