Distribution boxes must be designed to withstand temperature extremes, moisture, dust, UV exposure, and mechanical impacts to ensure safe and reliable operation.

Temperature and Heat

Distribution boxes are sensitive to ambient and internal temperatures. Standard electrical equipment typically operates safely up to 40°C, but outdoor boxes exposed to direct sunlight or internal heat from components can exceed 60°C, which may reduce metal conductivity, accelerate insulation aging, and increase contact resistance, potentially causing overheating or device failure . Thermal management features such as ventilation vents, heat sinks, or reflective coatings help mitigate these risks .

Moisture and Humidity

Moisture intrusion is a major threat. Water can enter through poorly sealed gaps, causing condensation, corrosion, and insulation degradation, which may lead to leakage currents, reduced metering accuracy, or safety hazards for maintenance personnel . Weatherproof enclosures with IP65-IP67 or NEMA 3R/4X ratings provide protection against rain, snow, and high humidity . Proper sealing with gaskets, RTV silicone, and regular maintenance of seals is essential for long-term reliability .
