The load protection of a distribution box ensures that each branch circuit is safeguarded against overloads, short circuits, and electrical faults through devices like MCBs, fuses, and RCDs.

Overview of Load Protection

A distribution box (also called a distribution board, load center, or breaker panel) receives power from the main supply and distributes it to multiple branch circuits. Its primary role in load protection is to prevent electrical faults from affecting the entire system. When a fault occurs in one circuit, the protective device for that circuit trips, isolating the problem while keeping other circuits operational .

Protective Devices

- Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs): Automatically disconnect a circuit when the current exceeds the rated load, protecting wiring and connected devices from overheating .
- Fuses: Provide overcurrent protection by melting when excessive current flows, interrupting the circuit .
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs) / Residual Current Circuit Breakers (RCCBs): Detect leakage currents to earth and disconnect the circuit, preventing electric shocks .
- RCBOs: Combine overcurrent and residual current protection in a single device, offering comprehensive load protection .
