

# Distribution Box Wiring Jumper Connection Method

Proper sizing is critical to maintain reliable connections and prevent overheating or failure under load conditions .

### Household Distribution Box Jumpers

In household distribution boxes, jumpers are sometimes used to connect the main switch to multiple branch circuit breakers. This method, often referred to as parallel wiring, involves connecting a wire from the main switch to the first breaker, then using jumpers to link subsequent breakers. However, this method is explicitly prohibited by national standards because it can create dangerous overload conditions. The first wire from the main switch may carry the sum of currents from all downstream breakers, potentially exceeding the wire's rated capacity and causing overheating without tripping the breaker .
