What is Distrobox?

Distrobox is a tool that lets you run any Linux distribution inside a container on your host system using Docker or Podman. It integrates the container with your host environment, sharing your \$HOME directory, graphical server (X11/Wayland), USB devices, D-Bus, and more, making containerized software behave like native applications. This allows you to test software, access distribution-specific packages, or maintain multiple development environments without changing your host OS or requiring root privileges.

Zsh Improvements in Distrobox

With Distrobox 1.8.1, Zsh users benefit from reworked completions that fix issues with container name completion and provide a more intuitive command-completion experience. This means when using Zsh inside or outside a Distrobox container, tab completion for Distrobox commands is smoother, reducing errors and improving workflow efficiency.

Setting Up Zsh with Distrobox

- Install Zsh: Most Linux distributions include Zsh in their repositories. Install it using your package manager (e.g., `sudo apt install zsh` for Debian/Ubuntu or `sudo pacman -S zsh` for Arch-based systems), .
- Set Zsh as Default Shell: Use `chsh -s $(which zsh)` and log out/in to activate Zsh .
