Common Causes of Tripping

- **Overload:** When the total current drawn by connected devices exceeds the breaker's rated capacity, the breaker trips to prevent overheating and damage. This often happens when multiple high-power appliances operate simultaneously .
- **Short Circuit:** Occurs when live and neutral wires touch, causing a sudden surge of current. This can result from damaged insulation, loose connections, or wiring faults .
- **Ground Fault or Leakage:** Electricity taking an unintended path to the ground, often due to moisture, damaged appliances, or faulty wiring, triggers residual current devices to trip .
- **Faulty Components:** Aging or damaged breakers and switches may trip without apparent reason. Replacing the defective component is often necessary .
- **Voltage Issues:** Undervoltage or voltage fluctuations can cause breakers with protective devices to trip automatically to prevent electrical damage .

Steps to Take After a Trip

- **Do Not Immediately Reset:** Avoid flipping the breaker back on without inspection, as this may worsen the problem .
- **Inspect the Circuit:** Check for visible signs of damage, burnt components, loose wires, or moisture around outlets .
