What is a Distribution Box?

A distribution box (also called a distribution board, panelboard, or breaker panel) is the central hub of an electrical system that receives power from the main supply and divides it into multiple subsidiary circuits. It ensures that electricity is distributed safely and efficiently throughout a building, whether residential, commercial, or industrial. The enclosure protects internal components and prevents accidental contact with live parts.

Key Components

- **Main Switch or Main Breaker:** Controls the entire electrical supply to the distribution box, allowing complete disconnection during emergencies or maintenance.
- **Circuit Breakers:** Automatic switches that protect individual circuits from overcurrent or short circuits. They trip when current exceeds safe limits and can be reset manually.
- **Busbars:** Metal strips that distribute incoming power to branch circuit breakers, ensuring stable voltage and current flow.
- **Neutral and Earth Bars:** Neutral bars collect return currents, while earth bars provide a safe path for fault currents to prevent electric shocks.
- **Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or RCBOs:** Detect leakage currents and cut off power to reduce the risk of electric shock.
