- **Accessibility:** The box should be easily accessible for maintenance and inspection. Leave sufficient space around the box for ventilation and future upgrades.
- **Height:** For residential or low-voltage setups, install at approximately 1.5 meters above ground. Industrial or high-voltage boxes may require customized heights based on surrounding equipment.
- **Manholes for Cross-Bonding:** In high-voltage systems, cross-bonding boxes are often placed in reinforced concrete manholes to protect against flooding and unauthorized access. The box should be positioned at the upper part of the manhole to avoid water accumulation and freezing in winter.
