Recommended Height

For wall-mounted or fixed distribution boxes, the bottom of the enclosure should be 1.2 to 1.5 meters above the ground. This height allows operators to perform routine maintenance, switch operation, and circuit inspection comfortably without bending or stretching, and ensures uniformity within the same building with minimal deviation (within 10 mm) for aesthetic and management purposes . For outdoor boxes, a minimum height of 3 feet (approximately 0.9 meters) is recommended to protect against water, dirt, and moisture damage . Ground-mounted boxes should be slightly raised, typically 2 to 4 inches, to prevent direct contact with water or damp surfaces .

Location Considerations

- Install in dry, well-ventilated, and easily accessible areas.
- Avoid locations with corrosive gases, liquids, or flammable materials.
- Ensure sufficient operating space around the box for at least two people to work simultaneously, facilitating maintenance and emergency handling .
- Keep the box away from wet areas, sinks, or uncovered outdoor spaces to prevent water ingress .
