Overview

This picture shows the interior of a typical distribution panel in the United Kingdom. The three incoming phase wires connect to the busbars via a main switch in the centre of the panel. On each side of the panel are two, for neutral and earth. The incoming neutral connects to the lower busbar on the right side of the panel, which is in turn connected to the neutral busbar at the top left. The incoming earth wire connects to the earth busbar at the top right.

An open circuit in a distribution box occurs when the electrical path is interrupted, preventing current from flowing to downstream circuits.

Understanding Open Circuits in Distribution Boxes

A distribution box (or distribution board) is a centralized unit that receives electrical power from the main supply and distributes it to multiple branch circuits, with protective devices like MCBs, RCCBs, or fuses installed for each circuit (). An open circuit happens when the connection between the incoming supply and the downstream load is broken, either intentionally or due to a fault. This interruption stops electricity from reaching the connected devices or areas.

Causes of Open Circuits

Open circuits in a distribution box can occur due to:

- Tripped circuit breakers or blown fuses: Protective devices disconnect the circuit to prevent overload or short circuits ().
