Importance of Labeling

- Prepare a single-line diagram for system-level understanding and a detailed wiring schematic for field wiring, showing feeders, protective devices, busbars, terminal numbers, conductor sizes, and cable routing .
- Ensure diagrams are version-controlled and include revision notes for future reference.
- Label Components and Wires
- Assign unique identifiers to all components (e.g., CB1, MCB2) and terminal blocks .
- Use durable labels with high contrast (e.g., white text on orange or yellow background) to ensure readability under various lighting conditions .
