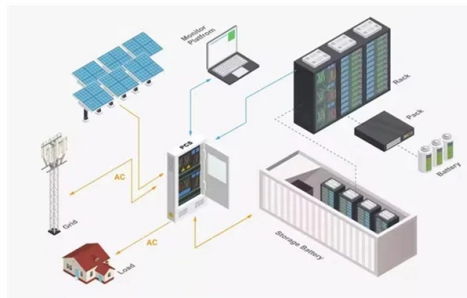


Does an outdoor small distribution box need to be grounded



Overview

The metal box of the distribution box, the electrical installation board, and the metal base and casing of the electrical appliances in the box must be grounded. The protective neutral wire should be reliably connected through the terminal board. Quick answer: Outdoor junction boxes must be weatherproof, properly sealed at all conduit entries, sized correctly for wire fill, and installed above grade unless specifically rated for burial. Outdoor lighting junction boxes must do more.
