Overview

Septic System Distribution Box

A septic distribution box, or D-box, is a passive junction that evenly distributes effluent from the septic tank to multiple leach lines in the drain field . It has a fixed number of outlet holes corresponding to the number of drain lines it serves. There is no “spare” outlet built into the box; all outlets are intended for active use. If a drain line fails or needs replacement, the box itself does not provide an extra outlet, but a plumber can modify the system to add additional lines or replace the box with one that has more outlets . Proper maintenance ensures that all outlets remain clear to prevent overloading any part of the drain field.
