Safety and Code Requirements

Electrical equipment, including distribution boxes, must be safeguarded against physical damage and unauthorized access. The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies that equipment likely to be exposed to physical damage must be protected by guarding or enclosing it in a manner sufficient to prevent harm, though it does not mandate a specific type of barrier such as a fence or bollard; the choice is left to the installer and the authority having jurisdiction . For example, pad-mounted transformers in parking lots are often fenced or protected with bollards to prevent vehicle impact .

Fencing Considerations

Fencing around electrical equipment serves multiple purposes:

- **Safety:** Prevents accidental contact with high-voltage components, reducing the risk of electrocution .
- **Security:** Deters unauthorized access, vandalism, or theft, which is particularly important for critical infrastructure like substations .
