- **Twist the Wires Together** Hold the stripped ends together and twist them clockwise until they are tightly joined. If using a pigtail with a terminal end (like a ring or spade), attach the terminal to the device or connector at this stage .
- **Secure the Connection**
 - **Wire Nut Method:** Place a wire nut over the twisted wires and twist the nut until it is tight and the wires are fully enclosed.
 - **Crimp Method:** Insert the wires into a crimp connector and use a crimping tool to secure them.
