A switch only needs a fiber optic transceiver if it is connecting to a fiber optic network; copper connections do not require one.

Role of Fiber Optic Transceivers

A fiber optic transceiver is a module that converts electrical signals from a switch into optical signals for transmission over fiber cables, and vice versa, enabling high-speed communication over long distances . Without a transceiver, a switch cannot directly communicate over fiber, as the switch's electrical ports are incompatible with optical signals .

When a Switch Requires a Transceiver

- Fiber-enabled switches: Modern switches often have SFP, SFP+, QSFP, or QSFP28 slots designed for optical transceivers .
- Long-distance or high-speed links: Fiber is used when copper Ethernet cannot cover the required distance or bandwidth, such as in data centers, campus backbones, or metro networks .
- Compatibility considerations: The transceiver must match the switch's supported data rate (1G, 10G, 25G, 40G, 100G) and the type of fiber (single-mode or multimode) being used .
