### Risks of Arc Faults

Arc faults are extremely dangerous because they generate intense heat and plasma, capable of igniting nearby materials almost instantly . Even small residential panels can produce explosive pressure, molten metal shrapnel, and UV/infrared radiation that can cause severe burns or structural damage . Arc faults are a leading cause of electrical fires in homes and commercial buildings.
