A dual-line fiber setup involves two separate fiber strands running from the provider's distribution network to a single home. This can be implemented in several ways:

- **Redundancy:** One fiber serves as a backup in case the primary line fails, ensuring continuous connectivity.
- **Increased Bandwidth:** Each fiber can carry independent data streams, effectively doubling the available bandwidth for high-demand households.
