- **Bolted Connections:** Standard bolts and nuts secure the branch fitting to the main tray. This method is robust and allows for future disassembly if needed.
- **Quick-Connect Systems:** Snap, slide, or twist fittings designed for rapid installation, often specific to a manufacturer. These are useful for large projects where speed is critical.
- **Clamps:** Used to secure branch trays to the main run, especially in lightweight or smaller installations.
