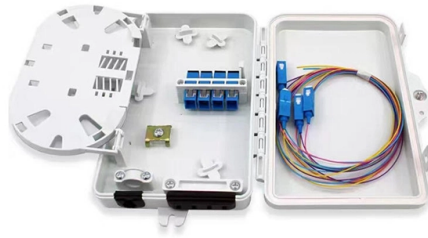


Emergency Handling of Low-Voltage Distribution Boxes

Key Safety Measures

Isolation and De-energization: Before any emergency intervention, identify and access the isolation point to quickly disconnect power if necessary. Live work should only be performed when de-energization is impractical, and only by trained personnel using appropriate PPE, including insulated gloves, non-conductive tools, and eye protection . **Risk Assessment:** Evaluate hazards such as electric shock, arc flash, fire, and trip hazards. Determine the likelihood and potential consequences of each hazard to establish the risk level. Maintain a clear work area for safe access and egress . **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Use insulated rubber gloves, non-conductive crooks, arc-rated clothing, and eye protection. For fire or burn incidents, have multi-trauma dressings and a fiberglass fire blanket available to smother flames from head to feet .
