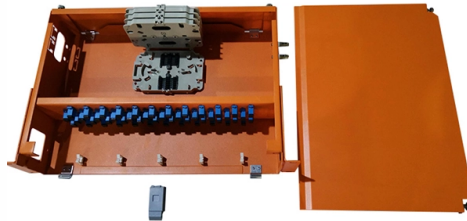

- Environmental Factors: Ice accumulation (up to 50mm) and wind speeds (up to 320 km/h) must be considered when determining maximum height and span .
