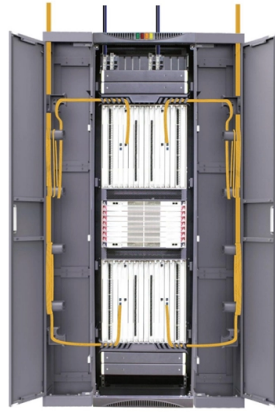


Fiber Optic Cable Rigid Sheath
