Optical Fiber Identifiers (OFIs)

Optical Fiber Identifiers detect signals by inducing a safe macro-bend in the fiber, allowing a small amount of light to escape. This light is then analyzed to determine the presence of network traffic, test tones, or continuous wave (CW) signals, and even the direction of the signal. Devices like AFL's OFIs and Fujikura's FID-31R provide accurate, non-disruptive detection, enabling technicians to trace fibers end-to-end, perform maintenance, and avoid service interruptions . These tools are essential for field operations in telecom, FTTH, and data center environments.
