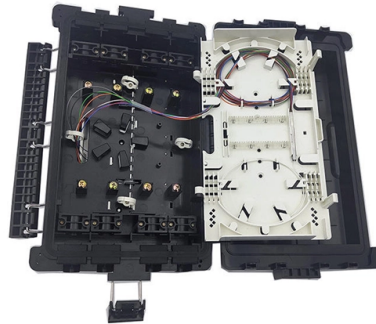

These fibers can absorb up to 100 times their weight in water, forming a stable gel that blocks water along the cable length. Lower-level SAP finishes, like Swellcoat™ Blocker, provide reinforcement and water-blocking for technical fibers or textiles, ensuring dry cable performance without compromising flexibility.
