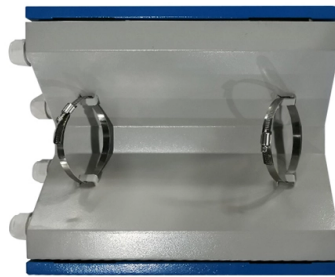


Fiber Optic Cable from Bus to Home

Routing from Street to Home

Fiber optic cables are typically delivered from a street-level distribution point, often called a bus or node, to a home using either underground conduits or aerial lines. Underground installation involves running the fiber through protective conduits buried beneath the ground, while aerial installation uses poles to suspend the cable above ground. The fiber terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts optical signals into electrical signals for use by home devices .

Fiber Types and Equipment

For residential FTTH installations, single-mode fiber is commonly used due to its ability to support long distances and high bandwidth. The fiber may be pre-terminated with connectors such as SC/APC or LC, simplifying installation and avoiding complex splicing . An optical transceiver or media converter may be used if the fiber needs to interface with Ethernet devices, providing electrical isolation and preventing interference .
