- Connector Termination

 - Commonly used for patching and temporary connections.
 - Requires precise fiber cleaving, cleaning, and polishing to minimize insertion loss and back reflection.
 - Tools include precision cleavers, polishing films, and visual fault locators (VFLs) to verify fiber integrity .
- Splicing
 - Fusion splicing is the most common method, permanently joining two bare fibers.
