Fiber jumpers, also known as fiber patch cords, are short optical cables with connectors at both ends used to link optical distribution boxes, transceivers, and network devices.

Purpose and Function

Fiber jumpers serve as the physical connection between optical transceivers and terminal boxes or between different network components within a fiber optic system. They enable the active transmission of light signals for data communication, ensuring reliable connectivity in optical fiber networks, local area networks, and telecommunication systems (). They are essential for both intra-rack connections and cross-facility cabling.

Types of Fiber Jumpers

Fiber jumpers are classified based on fiber type and connector type:

- Fiber Type
 - Single-mode fiber (SMF): Typically yellow with blue connectors, used for long-distance transmission (up to tens of kilometers) due to low attenuation ().
 - Multi-mode fiber (MMF): Usually orange or gray with beige or black connectors, suitable for short-distance connections (under 2 km) with higher modal dispersion ().
- Connector Type
 - LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor, commonly used with SFP modules, allows high-density connections in distribution frames ().
