- SC-to-FC Patch Cables: These are fiber optic jumper cables with an SC connector on one end and an FC connector on the other. They maintain signal integrity while bridging different connector types .
- SC-to-FC Adapters: These adapters allow two separate fiber cables—one SC and one FC—to be joined. They are commonly used in ODF panels, telecom racks, and lab setups .
