

Fiber optic broadband connected to two routers

Step 1: Understand Your Fiber Setup

Fiber optic internet delivers data via light signals through glass or plastic fibers, offering high speeds and low latency. The fiber line from your ISP terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the optical signal into an electrical Ethernet signal that your router can use. Most home setups provide a single ONT with one or more Ethernet ports. Directly connecting two routers to the ONT for independent internet connections is uncommon; instead, the second router usually extends or segments the network through the first router.

Step 2: Connect the Primary Router

- Plug the fiber optic cable into the ONT's optical port.
- Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) to connect the ONT's LAN port to the WAN port of your primary router.
- Power on the ONT first, wait for it to stabilize, then power on the router. Confirm connectivity via the router's status lights.

Step 3: Connect the Secondary Router
