Overview

Traditional fiber optic cables are tension-sensitive, especially sharp bends beyond the minimum bend radius. The stress affects light transmission through the fiber core, leading to significant power loss. In 2007, bend-insensitive fiber was introduced into the market to curb this. The correct bend radius calculation is a fundamental prerequisite for high-quality fiber optic installations and is decisive for long-term network performance and reliability.
