Fiber optic cable bundling wire involves grouping multiple optical fibers into precise configurations using specialized machinery and binder yarns to ensure gentle handling, mechanical stability, and customizable arrangements.

Fiber Bundling Process

Fiber optic cables are often pre-bundled before final cabling to protect delicate glass fibers and maintain precise alignment. Advanced fiber bundling systems, such as those developed by KURRE Systems, use a binder yarn spinner operating at up to 3,000 rpm to wrap a thin binder thread around multiple fibers. This process gently holds fibers together while minimizing mechanical stress, handling ultra-fine fibers with diameters from 0.2 mm to 1.2 mm and tensile forces as low as 0.2 N to 4 N . The binder yarn can also serve as a color-coding mechanism for easy identification of fiber bundles .

Bundle Configurations

Fiber bundles can be arranged in a variety of geometries and shapes depending on the application:

- Round, square, or hexagonal bundles for uniform light distribution
- Linear or grid arrangements for spectroscopy or instrumentation
- Fan-out or bifurcated (Y-cable) configurations for splitting or directing light to multiple outputs Bundles can include single-mode or multimode fibers, with core diameters ranging from 25 μm to 1800 μm and numerical apertures from 0.10 to 0.37 . Electrical wires can also be integrated with fiber bundles for hybrid applications.
