Steps to Connect Fiber to a Core Switch

- **Select the Correct Transceiver** Core switches typically require SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ transceivers compatible with the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and the desired speed (1G, 10G, etc.). Insert the transceiver into the designated SFP port on the core switch.
- **Choose the Appropriate Fiber Cable** Use pre-terminated fiber optic cables with connectors matching the transceiver type, such as LC-LC, SC, or MTP/MPO. Pre-terminated cables save time and reduce installation errors. Ensure the fiber type matches the transceiver: single-mode for long distances, multi-mode for shorter distances.
- **Connect the Fiber Cable** Plug the fiber cable into the transceiver, ensuring proper alignment and avoiding bending the fiber sharply, which can cause signal loss. Each fiber strand carries a single light signal, so pay attention to transmit (TX) and receive (RX) orientation.
- **Verify Network Topology** Decide on a star or daisy-chain topology. In a star topology, each switch connects directly to the core switch, providing high performance and resilience. Avoid loops unless using Spanning Tree Protocol (STP) to prevent network disruptions.
