Identifying Broken Fibers

Broken fibers occur when the glass core or cladding is physically severed or damaged, interrupting the light path and causing high attenuation or complete signal loss . Common causes include:

- Excessive bending beyond the minimum bend radius, leading to micro-cracks or breaks
- Crushing or over-tensioning during installation or from heavy equipment
- Environmental factors such as water ingress, UV exposure, or rodent damage
- Human error like accidental cuts during construction or maintenance Visual signs of damage include cracks, flattened jackets, sharp bends, or corroded connectors .

Locating the Fault

To pinpoint the exact location of a break:

- Visual Fault Locator (VFL): A red laser (650 nm) is injected into the fiber; light leakage indicates the break, ideal for short distances
- Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR): Sends light pulses through the fiber and measures reflections to locate breaks or high-loss points, suitable for long-distance or complex networks Accurate fault location prevents unnecessary cutting and ensures efficient repair.
