Low-Temperature Effects

At temperatures below -40°C , the polymer coatings and jackets of the cable can shrink and become brittle, creating axial compressive stress on the silica core. This can lead to microbending, which increases signal attenuation and may render the fiber inoperable below -55°C . Extreme cold also reduces flexibility, making installation and handling more challenging.
