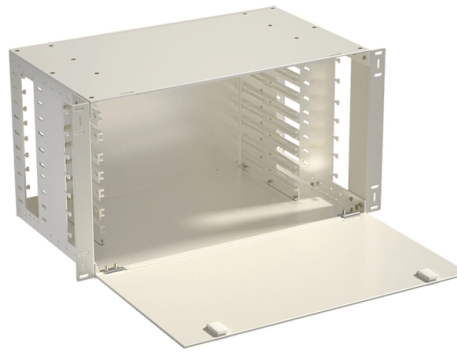


Fiber optic cable testing requires an FC connector

Fiber optic cable testing does not strictly require an FC connector; any compatible connector type can be used as long as it mates properly with the test equipment and reference cables.

Connector Compatibility in Testing

Fiber optic testing relies on connecting the cable under test to measurement equipment such as an optical power meter, light source, or OTDR. The key requirement is that the connector on the cable must physically mate with the test equipment or a reference launch cable. FC connectors (both FC/PC and FC/APC) are commonly used due to their threaded design and low insertion loss, but other connectors like SC, LC, or MPO can also be used depending on the system and test setup .

Testing Methods

There are two main testing approaches:

- Single-ended testing: Measures the loss of one connector at a time using a reference cable. This method is useful for patch cords or short cables where the fiber itself contributes negligible loss .
