- **Form Factors:** Common AOC form factors include SFP+, QSFP+, and QSFP28, supporting data rates from 10 Gbps to 400 Gbps depending on the cable type.
- **Custom Lengths:** AOCs can be manufactured in various lengths to suit specific deployment needs, typically for short-distance interconnects within racks or data centers.
