

Fiber optic cables also require routers

Fiber optic cables can be used with routers, but only through an intermediary device called an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) that converts light signals into electrical signals your router can understand.

How Fiber Connects to a Router

Fiber optic cables transmit data as pulses of light, which standard routers cannot interpret directly because they are designed to handle electrical signals over Ethernet. To bridge this gap, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is installed by your Internet Service Provider (ISP). The ONT receives the fiber signal and converts it into a standard Ethernet output that can be connected to your router's WAN port using an Ethernet cable .

Router Compatibility

Most home routers do not have fiber ports, but you can still use a normal router with fiber internet. The key is that the router connects to the ONT via Ethernet, not directly to the fiber cable. Some modern routers are fiber-ready and include SFP ports, which allow direct fiber connections, but these are typically higher-end models . For standard setups, any router with a WAN port can work as long as it is connected to the ONT.

Steps to Connect Fiber to a Router

- Install the ONT: The ISP installs the ONT where the fiber enters your home.
- Connect the fiber cable to the ONT: Plug the fiber optic cable into the ONT's optical port.
