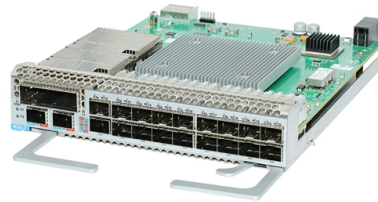


Fiber optic cables and electrical cables

Fiber optic cables can be combined with electrical cables in certain hybrid designs, but careful engineering is required to avoid interference, heat, and physical damage.

Hybrid Cable Designs

Utilities and manufacturers have developed hybrid cables that integrate both fiber optic and electrical conductors. Examples include:

- OPGW (Optical Power Ground Wire): Combines optical fibers with a metallic ground wire, typically installed on transmission towers .
- OPAC (Optical Power Attached Cable): Fiber cables attached to existing power or ground conductors to expand communication capacity . In these designs, the optical fibers are usually placed in a sealed metal tube surrounded by steel strength members and aluminum conductors. The fibers are immune to electrical interference, so the power transmission does not affect signal quality .

Installation Considerations

While hybrid cables are engineered for co-location, running standard fiber optic cables in the same conduit as electrical cables is generally not recommended due to several risks :

- Electromagnetic Interference (EMI): Fiber optics are resistant to EMI, but connectors and termination equipment may be affected by nearby electrical currents .
